The award given by the Genovis program recognizes Le Biscornu as having the best Canadian flock for Maternal Breeds in Quebec province. Sheep and flocks are evaluated according to Genovis' genetic evaluation system and must demonstrate high values on their respective indices. Maternal breeds for Canada include Border Cheviot, North County Cheviot, Border Leicester, Dorset, DLS (a Canadian breed using Dorset, Leicester and Suffolk), Polypay, Katahdin, and Icelandic.
